Organon: Methods used for Patient Organisation Disclosure 2025

This memo describes the methods used to publish financial and non-monetary benefits by Organon to patient organisations in Sweden. Patient organizations are non-profit entities that are mainly composed of patients and/or caregivers who represent and support the needs of patients and/or caregivers.

Patient organisations enable the pharmaceutical industry to become more patient-focused and improve their knowledge on the needs of people living with these diseases and conditions.

Activities between pharmaceutical companies and patient organizations are regulated by the European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries and Associations (EFPIA) and the local regulations of each country, and all cooperation between these parties must be transparent. Organon acts in accordance with these codes to ensure transparency and openness between the pharmaceutical industry and patient organisations across Europe.

This memo serves as a supplemental document to the annual report on the financial benefits to patient organizations. The memo describes the methods used to meet the requirements of EFPIA and local regulation regarding the disclosure.

This report presents:

- The form of support Organon provides to the patient organization, e.g. financial, indirect or non-financial support
- The nature of the support provided, referred to in the section ‘Description of the program / initiative’
- The amount of support provided in the local currency to the extent that the form of support has been economic.

Cross-border activities:

Regardless of which Organon entity provides the support, all Patient organisations whose principal place of business or business address is in Sweden are disclosed by Organon Sweden.

Report date:

Organon publishes the paid and non-monetary support in the previous calendar year no later than 6 months after the end of the reporting period in question (e.g., support for year 2025 will be published no later than 30 June 2026). The published information will be available for three (3) years on the company website.
